Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Travis County Emergency Services District No. 8 will be held via Tele-Conference in order to adhere to social distancing rules (see attached instructions for call in) on **Monday, August 3, 2020 at 6:15 p.m.**, at Station 801, located at 801 Bee Creek Road, Spicewood, Texas 78669, for the following purposes:

Due to the state of emergency and/or local disaster caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board of Commissioners of Travis County Emergency Services District No. 8 may hold its meeting via telephone conference call because of the difficulty and risks of convening a quorum in one location. Once initiated, the call will be broadcast at the meeting location and recorded as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act. The public may participate in the meeting via a conference system at 1-888-510-5505 and entering meeting ID 631545#.

1. Call meeting to order;
2. Public Comment on items not on the Agenda: Members of the public may speak for up to three minutes regarding general topics or specific agenda items. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of fifteen minutes on items not on the current agenda. In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners;
3. Public Comment on Agenda Items: Members of the public will speak on agenda items before Board consideration of item. Individual members of the public may address the Board once per item for a maximum of three minutes per person per agenda item. Members of the public who wish to speak on agenda items or make a public comment must complete speaker cards prior to the beginning of the Board meeting. Speaker cards will include the speaker's name, address, representation or affiliation (if any), and agenda items to be addressed;

Discussion/Action Items

4. Discuss District budget, tax rate notice, potential tax rate, and take any related action.
5. Discuss and designate a representative to calculate the no new revenue rate and the voter approval tax rate for the District.
6. Discuss agenda, time and date for next meeting; and
7. Adjourn.
