Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Travis County Emergency Services District No. 8 will be held on **Tuesday, January 20, 2026, at 5:15 p.m.**, at Station 801, located at 801 Bee Creek Road, Spicewood, Texas 78669, for the following purposes:

1. Call meeting to order;
2. Public Comment: Members of the public may speak for up to three (3) minutes regarding general topics or specific agenda items. This may not exceed 30 minutes in total unless approved by the board at the start of the meeting. In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners;
3. Public Comment on Agenda items: Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes per person per agenda item. This may not exceed 30 minutes in total unless approved by the board at the start of the meeting. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Members of the public will speak on agenda items before Board consideration of item. Members of the public who wish to speak on agenda items or make a public comment must complete speaker cards prior to the beginning of the Board meeting.

 - Briarcliff Extraterritorial Jurisdiction Project;
9. Discuss and consider taking action to create subcommittees for the following District projects.
 - Barton Creek Lakeside Firewise Community project;
 - Standing committee comprised of representatives from the Department to respond to requests from the community to speak at public events on the state of the department and special projects; and
 - Community Partner and Fire Department Relations;
10. Receive monthly President's report and consider taking related action;

11. Identify, prioritize and consider taking action on strategic management activities including:
 - Department relations with district entities;
 - Legislative update; and
 - Strategic Plan Update;
12. Receive monthly Fire Chief report and consider taking appropriate actions;
 - Emergency operations, response times, call volume;
 - Training;
 - Management activities, personnel, amendments to budget FY 2024/2025 or FY2025/2026 (and community impact, 801 remodel updates;
 - Apparatus needs; and
 - SAFE-D Presentation;
13. Receive report from Pedernales Association of Firefighters regarding fundraising efforts, social and membership events, and unresolved issues discussed at the Chief/Association/Board (aka "CAB") Committee meeting;
14. Receive monthly report from the District's attorney regarding pending litigation matters, contract issues, and legislative efforts and consider taking related actions;
15. Discuss and consider training requirements and compliance status for each Commissioner;
16. Discuss agenda, time, and date for next meeting; and
17. Adjourn.
